A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

ZEIJIANG COLLEGE OF SECURITY TECHNOLOGY

AND

ONE CAINTA COLLEGE

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOA") is entered into this 6th day of November 2023, by and between the:

The ZEIJIANG COLLEGE OF SECURITY TECHNOLOGY (ZCST) with principal address a Guoxi Subdistrict, Ouhai District, Wenzhou City, China, represented by its President DAI HAIDONG, and hereinafter referred to as ZCST;

The ONE CAINTA COLLEGE, educational institution established under the laws of Philippines and having an address at Hunter's ROTC Avenue Corner San Juan St. Barangay San Juan, Cainta Rizal Philippines, represented by its OIC College Administrator, DR. VICTORIA C. NAVAL and hereinafter referred to as OCC.

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT THERETO, both Parties hereby agree as follows:

1.SCOPE AND FIELDS OF ACADEMIC COOPERATIONS

- (1) The Parties hereby agree to implement within the framework of the rules and regulations applicable in each of the institutions and subject to availability of funds and resources, the following programs and activities, which may include, but not limited to:
 - (a) student and/or faculty exchanges;
 - (b) joint academic and research activities on the different field of expertise of both parties;
 - (c) joint seminars, trainings, conferences for faculty development;
 - (d) exchange of publications, reports and other academic materials and information; and
 - (e) sharing other activities and programs in areas of mutual interest, where such sharing shall result in benefit to both Parties.
- (2) It is agreed that the terms and conditions of any agreed program and activity contemplated in this MOA shall be the subject matter of separate written agreements to be negotiated and agreed upon by both Parties and/or any third Parties, wherever applicable. PROVIDED ALWAYS the

decision whether to initiate and/or implement any program or activity shall be at the sole discretion of each Party.

(3) The Parties agree to designate, on behalf of each institution, a coordinator whose responsibility will be to supervise the execution of this MOA and to draw up a programs or activities to be implemented under this MOA, setting out specific provisions concerning the exchange programs, budget requirements and details of funding.

1. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

(1) The Parties acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement in writing to the contrary, each Party will be responsible for its own costs and expenses in establishing and conducting programs and activities contemplated under this MOA, including without limitation its own costs and expenses in travel and accommodation subject to availability of funds.

2. JOINT PROPERTY

- (1) The Parties agree that any intellectual property rights arising from or in connection with any program or activity under this MOA, through and by the joint and collaborative efforts of both Parties shall be jointly owned and subject to any other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon in writing.
- (2) Both Parties shall acknowledge one another in any form of writing, publication or presentation based on research derived from the cooperative efforts of both Parties under this MOA, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing by the Parties.

3. CONFEDENTIALITY

(1) The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information or data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any program or activity conducted pursuant to this MOA save where the same is already in public domain.

4. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- (1) This MOA shall take effect on and form the date of execution of this MOA and shall continue to be effective for a period of three (3) years and may be extended for such further period as may be agreed by the Parties in writing.
- (2) Notwithstanding clause 5 (1) above, this MOA may be terminated by either Party giving written notice to the other at least three (3) months prior to the proposed date of termination.
- (3) Notwithstanding clause 5 (2) above, the provisions of this MOA or any agreement in respect of any on-going exchange program or any other form of cooperative activity under this MOA shall continue to apply until their completion unless both Parties mutually agree in writing to the earlier termination of the program or cooperative activity.

5.NOTICE

(1) Every notice, request or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MOA shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier (which shall be acknowledge by other Party) to the Parties at the address and contact number as stated below:
